

AB 1305 California Voluntary Carbon Market Disclosures Act Information (Section 44475.2)¹

Current revision as of 2025

In calendar year 2025, Keurig Dr Pepper (“we” or “our”) updated our 2030 GHG emissions-reductions targets to align to SBTi’s most current guidance, the Paris Agreement climate change goal of limiting global warming to 1.5C above pre-industrial levels. We have set goals to reduce absolute Scope 1 and 2 greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by 50% by FY2030 from a FY2018 base year and to reduce a portion of absolute scope 3 GHG emissions by 25% by 2030 from a 2022 base year, covering purchased goods and services, fuel and energy-related activities, upstream transportation and distribution and the use of sold products. We measure our GHG emissions in accordance with the Greenhouse Gas Protocol². We annually report progress against our targets, which have been validated by the Science Based Targets Initiative (SBTi). We intend to measure and disclose this information through our Impact Report, or equivalent reporting.
