Climate & Nature Action

- Reduced absolute Scope 1 and 2 GHG emissions by **18%** on the way to 50% by 2030
- Reduced absolute Scope 3 GHG emissions (Energy & Industry) by **8%** on the way to 25% by 2030
- Reduced absolute Scope 3 FLAG GHG emissions by **4%** on the way to 30% by 2030
- Supported regenerative agriculture and conservation on **198,132** acres of land since 2022 on the way to 250,000 acres by 2030
- Obtained **84%** of electricity from renewable sources

Employee Health, Safety & Well-Being

- Reported **82%** employee engagement among survey respondents

Water Use & Stewardship

- Replenished **62%** of water used in our beverages for high water-risk operating communities on the way to 100% by 2030
- Achieved water use ratios of **2.03** (all beverage facilities) and **1.87** (high water-risk locations) on the way to 1.8 and 1.6 by 2030, respectively

Packaging & Circular Economy

- Incorporated **16%** PCR plastic in primary plastic packaging on the way to 25–35% by 2035
- Used **21%** virgin plastic across our packaging portfolio
- Designed **96%** of packaging for recyclability, compostability or reuse
- Diverted **92%** of manufacturing waste from landfill

Human Rights, Responsible Sourcing & Supply Chain Livelihoods

- Responsibly sourced **97%** of coffee and **100%** of cocoa
- Achieved **94%** of brewer and ingredient suppliers meeting or exceeding expectations in a Responsible Sourcing audit
- Supported **10,061** farmers and workers in our coffee supply chain with the aim to improve their economic resilience since 2024

Consumer Health & Well-Being

- Provided positive hydration in **61%** of U.S. products
- Reduced added sugar in U.S. Refreshment Beverages by **10%** since 2020
